1. Make sure your group pronounces your vocabulary *clearly and loudly*.
2. Avoid “yes / no” questions in your discussions. These are called *closed-ended questions*. They don’t allow long answers.

Use *open-ended questions*; for example:

- Have you ever...? → When did you ...?
- Do you think this is useful? → Why is this useful?
  
- What do you think ...?
- Tell me about a time when ....
