You need to include the following parts in your introduction:

1. **a hook statement** (1-2 sentences)
 - directly relate the hook to your topic
 - make the hook catch the reader's attention
2. **general statements** (10-12 sentences)
 - give general information about your topic
 - organize your information using funnel organization
3. **thesis statement** (3-4 sentences)
 - include your topic, main idea and three subtopics in the thesis statements

Format:

1. Type your Introduction in MS Word.
 - Times New Roman font, size 12
 - double-spacing (2 行)
 - include your essay's title, your name, university name, and date
 - include a header with your essay's title and page number

★ See the model introduction. Your introduction should look exactly like the model.
 2. Use the following file format for the name of your document:
 - AW-Intro-given name
 - e.g. AW-Bib-Nanami
 3. Attach your introduction as a document in your email.
 4. In the subject name of your email, use the following format:
 - AW: Introduction-given name
 - e.g. AW: Introduction-Nanami
- ★ Introductions must be submitted on time to receive corrections. Those submitted late do not receive corrections.
- ★ "Computer problems" are not an acceptable excuse for late tasks. Manage your time to avoid problems.
