- \_\_\_\_\_ The Lagos elite in the west still prefers RP while other promote Standard Nigerian English.
  - The colonial administration set up schools in the north and brought in English teachers from England who were RP speakers.
    - After Nigeria gained its independence in \_\_\_\_\_, the Nigerian capital was built in Abuja because it was not a place where any of the three major local languages were spoken.
- \_\_\_\_\_ The British set up a trading post in Lagos in \_\_\_\_\_, but Nigeria did not become an official colony until \_\_\_\_\_.
  - In contrast, the English teachers in the south were missionaries and their main concern was teaching gospel rather than English.
