# Identify the themes in the following stories.

## 1. A Christmas Carol

A miserable old man, Ebenezer Scrooge, never gives any of his employees Christmas bonuses or holidays. Three ghosts visit him on Christmas Eve and they force him to re-examine his life. After those experiences, Scrooge becomes a happy, generous old man who enjoys Christmas.

Months later, Androcles is to be sacrificed to the biggest, hungriest lion in front of the crowds at the Coliseum. He sits waiting for the lion to attack, but the lion runs toward him and lick his hand. It is the lion he had helped. The crowd is surprised when they learn about the story. Both Androcles and the lion become heroes.
